The successful candidate will plan and implement spiritual enrichment, community service, and fellowship opportunities for middle and high school students with oversight from the Senior Pastor through the recruitment, training, and support of volunteer teams.

St. Paul's has a sparkling confirmation class ready to enter full participation in the life of the Church, and we are seeking a youth ministries coordinator to keep this momentum.

This role requires:

- The ability to complete the United Methodist Church's <u>Safe Sanctuaries</u> training to reduce the risk of abuse to children, youth, and vulnerable adults. *Please note: The Safe Sanctuaries program requires that staff leading youth programs be at least five years older than the oldest student present.*
- Experience and demonstrated competence in working with youth and coordinating youth programs.
- A commitment to St. Paul's values and attention to your own spiritual life.
- Excellent written and verbal skills for communicating with teens, parents, volunteers, and other members of the community.
- A valid NYS Driver's license and acceptable driving record.
- An Associate's Degree or equivalent experience related to position responsibilities.

Hours and wages:

This is a 10 hour/week position paying \$18.00/hour and includes paid time off and pro-rated benefits. The nature of the position requires as much evening and weekend work as needed to meet the responsibilities of the ministry.
